Slope Intercept Form Before graphing linear equations, we need to be familiar with slope intercept form To understand slope intercept form, we need to understand two major terms: The slope and the y -intercept Slope (m): The slope measures the steepness of a non-vertical line It is sometimes referred to as the rise over run

Chapter 3 - 4 Graphing Lines in Slope Intercept Form

The y-intercept of the line is the y-coordinate of the point where the line intersects the y-axis, $(0, \square)$ The y-intercept of the graph of $y = 2x + 1$ is $(0, 1)$ because the line crosses the y-axis at that point The slope-intercept form of a linear equation is $y = \square x + \square$ where \square is the slope and \square is the y-intercept
